Timber Ridge Road Maintenance

BWD, last years contractor for snow plowing, is finalizing a proposal to submit to

the Board for the upcoming snow removal season.

Bobby will also look into other snow removal contractors as possible alternatives

to BWD.

Timber Ridge Mill Levy Assessment

The Metro District is in the process of evaluating projected revenue increases

based on the increased property value assessments CTRMD received this year,

plus the higher interest rate returns we're making on CTRMD's investments. We will examine the data and compare an estimated cash flow analysis, including

possible effects of Proposition HH being passed, to determine the mill levy to

certify to Archuleta County Commissioners, which is due December 15, 2023.

The 15 mill levy(10 mill levy and 5 mill levy) for CTRMD is "de-bruced, which is

the act of eliminating the government spending limit and allowing that government to retain and spend all of the revenue it collects under existing tax

rates.
